

INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR STATEMENT OF INTEREST

This is a high-responsibility program, so we ask that your Statement of Interest show attention to detail, self-awareness, and your ability to follow structured guidance. Your application will be evaluated in part on the basis of whether you read and follow protocols accurately, because that is a big part of our program (and of health care in general). Please respond to the following prompts in 300 words or fewer, using the numbering format below:

1. Your name and expected year of graduation.
2. How you heard about this opportunity (e.g., a referral, campus event, website link).
 - a. 3. Your proposed weekly 2-hour shift(s) (Monday–Friday). Use “AM” for 7:30–12:30 and “PM” for 12:00–5:00. If your schedule doesn’t allow a full shift, explain how you’d cover 2 hours weekly in multiple blocks.

Example:

- Monday AM
 - Thursday PM
3. A brief example of a time when you demonstrated a key PSC value or qualification (see qualifications listed on the PSC intern job description). A short anecdote is best.
 4. Dartmouth Health Patient Support Corps Intern Program
 5. Languages you speak fluently, other than English.
 6. A few sentences about how you’ll balance your commitments—including PSC, research, coursework, and self-care. If accepted, what will you scale back to focus on PSC?
 7. (Optional) Any barriers or special circumstances you'd like us to be aware of, and whether you’d like to request an exception.

Your responses (items 1–7) must fit within 300 words total. We appreciate your time and effort in preparing this thoughtfully.
